ADVENTURE UNLIMITED!!

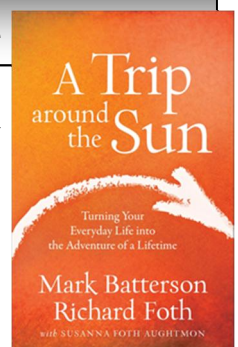

SEE YOU ON THE ROAD

It's that time again: Get yer Ride In Line!!

That is, get all your maintenance in order. This is the time of year for the "Get Those " done, Such as:

- 1) Tires changed, if needed. If you're not sure, you can ask a few guys around here, and they would be happy to take a look , and let you know if your in need. Tires are a big problem when they start getting slick, and even worse when they blow out.
- 2) Oil changed, and other important lubricants, like Primary and Transmission. Its easy to get into the "just change the oil" thing, but its best to refer to your owners manual for specific intervals. It really does matter.
- 3) Brakes, front and rear, I change them both at the same time usually, since I'm already down there, and truth be told I brake pretty evenly, which is to say, usually real hard, so I tend to go through brakes a lot.
- 4) Air Filter— One of those forgotten things that can make yer bike run a lot better, and save you bucks at the pump.

There may some other things that you need to look at, there are plenty of peep's around here that will be happy to help out.

We have a lot of riding lined up for this year, and we want everyone to have safe, joyful time on the road.

Which brings me to "Rides" in general.

We started a cool thing we call the "Run Cards" This is something you don't want to miss out on at the beginning of each ride.

Not only does it have clear and easy directions to where we are all going, but it has safety tips on the back, that are equally important for the novice "pack" rider as they are for the "old pro's". Its basically a "How to not crash" course in pack riding. I have learned over the years , that the success of a Fun, Joyful ride starts at the front of the pack. If we're riding like I do when I'm alone, or with a select few, most will NOT have much fun, but feel like they are on an E-Ticket Ride at Dismo-land.

On the other hand, if its done at a nice pace, mellow lane changes with lots of room for everyone to get over, and a well planned route with some places to stop and stretch the legs, it usually always turns out that the whole family is ear to ear grins, wiping the bugs off their teeth, and laughing it up. Being a BEAUTIFUL example of the happy people Jesus called us to be. It makes the Roadhouse Freakshow a much more attractive thing to a lost and broken world, and that's what it's really all about, right?
